Carriage for Forklift

Carriage for Forklift - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizings of hook type tine carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is more or less 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type forks could be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades may differ by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the tine. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
